Update:

Hohidiai is a medical centre and family-based orphan care in a remote and very poor part of Indonesia. Entrust has been partnering with Hohidiai since 1999, and since 2011 we have been investing in local leadership for Hohidiai. We have been supporting Steve to undertake accountancy training, which he has been doing part time while also working as a key part of the leadership team at the centre.

Since Entrust began funding Steve, he married Naomi and they now have a son. All the while Steve has continued with his studies and his duties at Hohidiai. At times juggling full-time work and part-time study with family life has been challenging but Steve has persevered.

Naomi, Steve's wife is a GP and has a narrow window of opportunity now to undertake further study to specialise in TB and respiratory health. To do this they need to move to another part of the country, leaving Hohidiai for a season. Steve plans to finish his studies while Naomi undertakes her specialist studies. Steve and Naomi left Hohidiai at the end of July.

It was very difficult decision for them, but they believe that this further study and a chance to complete Steve's studies will be of great benefit to Hohidiai down the track. We know that the investment we have made in Steve will not be wasted. We spent five years investing in his accounting degree, but more than that, investing in Steve as an emerging leader.

We have seen him grow in that time and we are sure that the skills and abilities he developed at Hohidiai will be used wherever he goes. We are pleased with this investment, and know it will reap great returns for Indonesia, for Steve and Naomi – and for Hohidiai.
