Update:

Entrust met our partner when they had already started building a community centre in a remote area of Northern India. The centre was to provide services for 20 surrounding villages. Our partner had already put in a lot of their time and effort to get the building half-finished, but had run out of resources. Entrust stepped in with \$20,000 to finalise the building.





In October we visited the completed building and were very impressed. The building is now complete and in operation. It acts as a base for community health workers to operate from. It also serves as a library and a place to conduct adult literacy learning. It also functions as a place for a children's club. The building is well suited to it's location and purposes, and the community is extremely grateful for the presence of our partners in their midst. This part of Northern India is extremely lacking in development, and this centre is key to our

partner's plans to lift the standard of living to that of people living in the cities.

While completing the building, the retaining wall collapsed, requiring further funds and the addition of a stronger wall and a new room to support this. Rather than come back to us, our partners found a solution themselves. They are fully invested in the communities they serve and have an amazing
