Resource Centre to Upskill the Vulnerable - Uganda

Budget: \$20,000 – fully funded!

Update:

Our partners are located in the eastern region of Uganda, not far from the Kenyan border in a regional town. Since 2000 they have been caring for orphans and underprivileged children and their families who have struggled to gain an education.

The project has now been completed. Our partner's aim was to build the next step of a half-built Resource Centre to lock-up stage which will be used for vocational skills training, school assistance and research, internet access and will start the beginnings of a library. It will also be available for the parents of the children.



We are pleased to report that the final six months of the project has been successful, despite price fluctuations in the Ugandan economy. In the first six months of the project:

- Roof materials were purchased and the roof completed
- Doors and window frames were fitted
- Lock-up stage was completed

In the final six-month period:

- Glass was fitted to the windows and doors
- The building was painted
- Plastering was completed



Going forward, our partners said, *"We are using the building as much as we can for which we are very grateful. We have even had groups sleep over when they are receiving training! The community has been engaged by providing labour and security of the construction materials on site. In the future we would like to finish the tiling of the floor and the electrical work and water systems. The will allow us to fully utilise all aspects of the Resource Centre's planned educational use. We are grateful that Entrust has helped us complete this phase of the building which has allowed us to arrive at the final stage of building."*
