
Full Circle Education


Budget: \$27,000 fully funded.

Update:

Our partner works in eight slums around Phnom Penh with families and children not yet in school. They follow these children through their full circle, which for some is to University and beyond. This project is part of our partner's Education Program and provides activity centres that are run with the express purpose of providing tuition and catch-up classes in Khmer and basic Mathematics as well as providing time and space for children to do their homework and participate in other classes (English, Computer, Art, Music & Sport).

This program is more than just supporting poor children to start school. Our partner is excited about the young adults they have





The young adults (pictured below) are just some of the leaders who are identifying and providing catch-up classes for up to 170 children this year. The centres provide high quality, creative after-school teaching in a safe learning environment. The kids receive healthy snacks so their nutrition is improving and because they enjoy studying at the centres their rankings in government schools are increasing.
