
## **Tanks and Toilets**


Budget: \$19,520. \$15,000 funded.

**Update:** Many people living in central Sulawesi are very poor, barely surviving on subsistence agriculture. The government provides few services, the roads are in poor condition and school attendance is low as children are required to work on the family farm to survive. Access to clean water and toilets will significantly improve the living conditions in this area. This project is community-based.

On September 28, 2018, a devastating earthquake and tsunami struck northern Sulawesi causing the deaths of 4000+ people. The natural disaster delayed commencement of the project until February 2019 when the soil was more stable and limited resources were once more available and had returned to a reasonable sale price.

The project started slowly as the local villagers were learning the skills needed to construct the toilets. Skilled construction
