Overview

Budget \$30,000

Tehri Garwhal is situated in Northern India, high up in the Himalayas. It is an extremely remote area with poor infrastructure and limited access to schooling. Entrust currently supports a school for a growing number of children who would otherwise not receive an education. By early 2022, the rented building for the school was in very poor condition with damaged, crumbling concrete, mould and decaying windows, making all but three classrooms unsafe and unusable. Most classes were held outdoors, but with the looming monsoon season, the need for a suitable building became urgent. This project funded a transitional building for the school to move into, housing classrooms, staff room, principal's office, washrooms, a computer lab and a small library. Once permanent classrooms are erected on the new site, the transitional building will become a multi-use facility for assemblies, sports and other school activities and will be integrated into the overall development of the new school facility.

## Impact for Apr - Nov 2022

- Eight classrooms, an office, staffroom and a computer laboratory and library have been erected and 5 toilets built.
- Students happily transitioned to the incomplete building in a safer location (off the main road) with a larger playground area in July and the fully functional library/computer laboratory was inaugurated in November.
- Community members partially built the road that leads to the school and will contribute labour towards the retaining wall behind the building in stage two.
- Electricity has been connected and the water connection has been approved.
